## **End of Tenancy Cleaning Checklist**



# Front of property Wipe down front door, hinge and ledge Sweep pathway or driveway

Tidy up any flower beds

. . . .

Mow front lawn

 Clean the glass on any windows and wipe down frames

### Hallway

- Wipe down skirting boards, door frames and radiators
- Wipe down the inside of front door
- O Vacuum
- Shampoo carpet or clean tiles/laminate with floor cleaner

#### Stairs

- Wipe skirting on stairs and banisters
- Use extension on vacuum to reach cobwebs on landing ceiling above stairs
- Vacuum stairs
- Shampoo carpet or wipe each step down

#### **Kitchen**

- Ensure cupboards and drawers are clear then wipe inside with a damp cloth
- Wipe top of cupboards with damp cloth
- Spray sides with multi-purpose cleaner and wipe down
- Spray tiles with multi-purpose cleaner and wipe down
- Thoroughly clean any appliances that came with the property
- Clean the oven if you are not hiring a professional
- Spray the sink and taps with limescale remover, leave to soak then wipe down
- Wipe down hob and front of oven
- Pour drain cleaner down sink
- Wipe down skirting boards
- Vacuum get behind appliances and under cupboards if possible

Clean floor

#### Living room

- Wipe down door frames and skirting boards
- Clean any scuffs off walls
- Use vacuum attachment to clear any cobwebs from corners and ceiling
- Clean any mirrors or glass (windows and doors) in the living room
- O Vacuum
- Clean carpet or laminate flooring

#### **Bedrooms**

- Clean skirting boards and door frames
- Wipe any scuffs from walls
- Use vacuum to remove any cobwebs
- Clean windows and any mirrors
- Use vacuum attachment to dust bed frame and mattress, if provided by landlord
- Clean carpet or laminate flooring

#### Garden

- Spray weed killer the day before if possible then pull up weeds
- Rake up any rubbish or dead leaves and throw these away
- O Mow lawn
- Brush down patios, walkways and decking
- Clean out the shed and sweep

#### **Bathroom**

- Spray washroom cleaner around bath and sink, leave to soak then wipe off
- Use damp cloth to wipe down sides, shelves, radiator, toilet cistern and around skirting boards
- Use disposable wipes to clean toilet
- Wipe down any plumbing behind the toilet
- Spray tiles with multi-purpose cleaner then wipe
- Spray any mould, leave to soak then wipe away
- Use a limescale remover to get rid of build up on taps
- Bleach toilet and close lid
- Clean mirrors and windows with glass cleaner and wipe
- Vacuum behind toilet and sink
- Clean floor
